

Industry Alert: Brace For a Printer Surge as Microsoft Ends Legacy Driver Support this Year

Just as the end of Windows 10 support triggered an unusually high PC refresh cycle, Microsoft's decision to end legacy printer driver support in Windows 11 will force enterprises to retire functional hardware and create predictable volume surges for ITAD providers over the next 18 months, but this time, the obsolescence targets peripherals still in daily use.
