



Summary: ITAD M&A Activity: Transaction Trends, Buyer Strategy and Market Direction

This report analyzes twenty-two IT asset disposition (ITAD) mergers and acquisitions between October 2024 and July 2026, sourced from public disclosures, industry coverage, and company statements. It examines deal frequency trends, buyer composition (private equity platforms, conglomerates, and a newly identified category of outside strategic capital from materials and metals companies), and cross-references transaction activity against Compliance Standards' April 2026 primary research report on the independent ITAD operator sector, including its scarcity thesis, founder succession-cliff pattern, and governance-orchestrator framework. Topics covered include DMD Systems Recovery, Telamon, Paladin EnviroTech, Sumitomo, and the data-center decommissioning demand driving current sector consolidation.
